All qualifying events can self-submit their event details along with an event photo (**300 x 173 jpeg image**) **we do not post logos, ads or posters and they will be deleted if submitted.** If you are unsure how to enter your photo you may send it in a separate email to lklan@travelmanitoba.com and it will entered for you. You are also able to include a description of up to 1250 characters. If you have a photo credit for your photo please bold it and include it in the description field, it will count as part of your 1250 characters. You are able to submit events whenever it is convenient for you.

Events must contain a phone number or email address for the general public to contact if questions arise about event.

To have your event included on our website, please review the criteria sheet and fill in the information at: <http://www.travelmanitoba.com/trip-essentials/submit-an-event/>. Events entered online that meet the guidelines will be on our website usually within 7 working days of submission.

NOTE: Events are listed only on travelmanitoba.com. Unlike past years, there is no longer a detailed listing of events in the printed Vacation Guide. There are several reasons for this:

- The Vacation Guide will be printed in December each year. At this time, many organizations do not have confirmed event schedules. Rather than provide an incomplete listing to our visitors, the website offers a complete, up-to-date listing as event dates are confirmed.
- Changes to event details can easily be made on the website, unlike in print. This improves the accuracy of information provided to visitors.
- Research shows that the majority of visitors use the web for trip planning rather than print publications. Improving the completeness and timeliness of our web listings is in line with the way visitors want to research their destination and plan their trips.

Event Listing Criteria Sheet

Event Criteria

Events listed with Travel Manitoba must also meet more than one of the following criteria:

- Be open to the public
- Be of interest to tourists
- Have the ability to draw visitors from beyond the immediate area
- If sporting in nature, the event must be at the provincial, interprovincial or national level
- **CONFIRMED START AND END DATES OF EVENT REQUIRED**
- **EVENTS MUST CONTAIN A PHONE NUMBER OR EMAIL ADDRESS FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC TO CONTACT IF THEY REQUIRE FURTHER INFORMATION**

A few suggestions of eligible events include:

- Spring or Fall Suppers, Fish Fry, Lobster Feasts, Perogy Suppers
- Farmers' Markets
- Theatre Performances, Dinner Theatres, Concerts, Music Festivals, Film Festivals
- Art Exhibits, Museum Exhibits, Craft Shows, Quilt Shows
- Christmas Events (Parades, Christmas lights tours etc.)
- Horse Shows, Dog or Cat Shows
- Home and Garden Shows
- Winter Carnivals
- Fishing Derbies (Summer or Winter), Snowmobile Derbies, ATV Derbies
- Canada Day Events, Easter Events
- Festivals (Spring, Summer, Fall & Winter), Wine & Beer Festivals
- Fairs, Expos, Rodeo's
- Walks, Runs, Marathons
- Car, Motorcycle & Boat Shows

Exclusions for listings include:

- Picnics, mother's day and father's day brunches, buffets and teas, dances and contests, ladies and men's nights
- Socials and beer gardens
- Local baseball, soccer games, hockey tournaments, golf tournaments or curling bonspiels
- Camps – day camps, summer camps, library readings, etc.
- Read-a-thons
- Rummage sales, plant sales, antique sales, garage sales, yard sales, flea markets and other private sales
- War memorials or November 11 memorials
- Opening or closing days for museums, swimming pools, skating and curling arenas, golf courses etc
